Machinery Risk Assessment – the role of standards

Purpose:

The Essential Health and Safety Requirements (EHSRs) of the Machinery Directive are the legal requirements which all machinery has to meet before it can be legally sold in Europe, but they are very generic and can be difficult to apply. European standards provide a presumption of conformity with the Directive and can significantly reduce the amount of risk assessment work required when CE marking machinery. This course will look at the relationship between the EHSRs, the standards and the risk assessment process and help machinery designers and project managers to minimise the work required while still ensuring full compliance with the Directive.
