

## CE and UKCA Marking Machinery and Industrial Equipment (CE02)

---

This course will give you an understanding of how to carry out a machinery assessment, including finding and applying the relevant standards, and producing and compiling the appropriate documentation. You will gain the relevant skills, understanding and confidence to enable you to manage the CE or UKCA marking process yourself.

- Responsibilities
- PUWER and workplace safety legislation
- Relation to other directives, including EMC, Low Voltage, Pressure Equipment and ATEX
- Control reliability
- Technical documentation, declarations and certificates

Anyone involved in specifying machinery: design engineers, project managers, importers, and health and safety professionals. Attendees are expected to have a basic understanding of what CE and UKCA marking is before they attend. Please see our Introduction course as a prerequisite.
