

The Construction Products Regulation

(CE05)

The Construction Products Regulation came into force in July 2012, replacing the Construction Products Directive. Construction products manufactured after this date may require CE or UKCA marking and this course will give delegates a thorough understanding of what they need to do.

Topics covered:

- Legal structure and scope
- Changes between the CPD and CPR
- The role of harmonized standards & approval documents
- Declaration of Performance
- Responsibilities including Notified Body involvement
- Factory Production Control (FPC)

Who should attend?

Anyone who is responsible for manufacturing, importing or supplying products for the construction industry: designers, purchasers, importers, inspection staff, structural steel fabricators, quality managers, and project managers. Attendees are expected to have a basic understanding of what CE and UKCA marking is before they attend. Please see our Introduction course as a prerequisite.
