



Buying Machinery: Safety Compliance (CE14)

Anyone involved in the purchase of machinery needs to have an understanding of the CE marking requirements so that they can specify their machinery correctly, include relevant contract clauses with purchase orders, check that all documentation is present and correct, and to ensure that they are meeting their workplace safety obligations.
